



Covered Employment and Wages Address Verification Project
Part I: City of San Jose
May 15, 2003

The Labor Market Information Division participated in a special project, funded by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics' **Covered Employment and Wages (ES-202) Program**, to **verify address information** of employers in Santa Clara and Sacramento Counties **and assign geographic codes** (longitude and latitude coordinates) to those employers. The following charts and maps display localized data for the City of San Jose that are based on the verified address information.




In San Jose, the three industry sectors employing the highest number of workers are the manufacturing, retail trade, and the professional, scientific, and technical services sectors. Manufacturing is the largest sector in the city, in terms of employment, employing over one out of every five workers in the sector (66,338 workers out of a total employment of 324,430).

San Jose Employers by Industry Sector Quarter 2002-1



The professional, scientific, and technical services, retail trade, and healthcare and social assistance sectors had the most reported employers in San Jose. The professional, scientific, and technical services sector had the most establishments with 16.6 percent of employer establishments (2,911 employer establishments out of a total of 17,543).



The manufacturing sector paid the most wages in San Jose, accounting for just over 32.0 percent of wages paid by employers located in the city (\$1.4 billion out of a total of \$4.35 billion in wages).

San Jose's disposable income is ranked No. 2 in the U.S., based on median household income of \$71,000. (San Jose Mercury News, April 2001)

Focus on Major Industries

The maps provided on the following pages provide a geographic display of employment and wage information collected for the Covered Employment and Wages (ES-202) Program from employers in key industries in San Jose. The maps are shown in ranges by Census tract. Darker colors indicate larger numbers of employees working in that Census tract. Natural breaks classification was used to determine the ranges, with slight adjustments made for readability. Census tracts within San Jose in which disclosure criteria are not met are shown in white.

Below is a brief description of those industries along with their North American Industry Classification (NAICS) codes.

Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services NAICS sector 54. This sector is comprised of establishments that specialize in performing professional, scientific, and technical activities for others. Activities performed include:

- Legal advice and representation
- Accounting, bookkeeping, and payroll services
- Architectural, engineering, and specialized design services
- Computer, consulting and research services
- Advertising and photographic services
- Translation and interpretation services
- Veterinary services


Retail Trade NAICS sectors 44-45. This sector is comprised of establishments engaged in retailing merchandise, generally without transformation, and rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise.

Retailers are organized to sell merchandise in small quantities to the general public. This sector comprises both in-store and direct-sale retailers.

Manufacturing NAICS sectors 31-33. This sector is comprised of establishments engaged in mechanical, physical, or chemical transformation of materials, substances, or components into new products. Activities performed include:


- Food manufacturing and processing
 - Apparel manufacturing
 - Printing and related support activities
 - Chemical, plastic, rubber, and metal manufacturing
 - Transportation equipment manufacturing




















